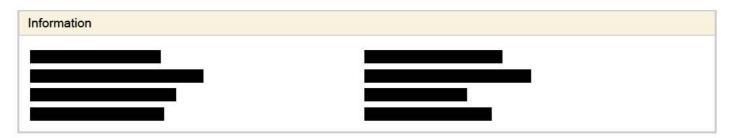

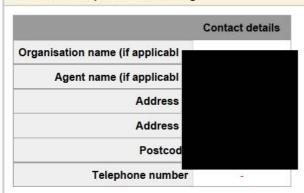

The plan has not considered or taken into account sufficiently a number of significant pieces of information.

Firstly the brown field register, which I have reviewed, is incomplete. It clearly has a number of omissions and therefore the amount of brownfield land that the plan is based on is too low.

In addition, the closure (or at that time likely closure) of Fiddlers Ferry power station was not adequately considered. It affords significant brown filed land for future employment and/or housing and the plan needs to be reviewed in light of the "baseline" assumptions being rectified.
