the plan does not set out sufficient or compelling reasons for the cessation of greenbelt status for significant parts of south Warrington. The plan has not taken into account the amount of current and future brownfield sites especially now the closure of Fiddlers Ferry has been confirmed.

The plan has not put sufficient detail or emphasis on the right to build regulations which would ensure bespoke, character housing for the new build required, which could be on brownfield or in fill sites.

the plan makes unsubstantiated assumptions about employment opportunities in the south of the borough and relies on infrastructure that is not in place and/or unlikely to be in place from government funding.

the involvement and engagement of residents in designing the plan has been insufficient to meet the legal duties of the Council. For example the Neighbourhood plans have not been completed and have therefore not been taken into account. there is little evidence of involvement and engagement just consultation after the plan is finalised which means the duty has not been met.
