I am writing to object strongly to the proposed Development plans across Warrington and TPT bypass.

I live in Stockton Heath and one of my main concerns is the increased traffic that these plans would bring to the road network in Warrington, a network which is already clogged. I drive around the country [REDACTED] and the traffic in Warrington is significantly worse than all of the areas I regularly travel to and around. This does not seem to have been considered by the plan at all. The current traffic situation is terrible so many additional cars on the roads in the area, is very concerning.

I regularly use the green spaces in the greenbelt land earmarked for development, I use this for walking my dog and leisure time with my family, it would be a real shame to see these spaces lost as they are one of the main reasons my family and I moved to the area.

An additional number of commuters on the roads and increased demand on road services which are already very stretched. I would much prefer to see the current infrastructure improved rather than growing the Town into a City and adding new suburbs. I like living in a Town, I chose to live in a Town rather than a City and do not want Warrington to become a city. I like that Warrington is a town, like the green spaces and have chosen to bring my family up here because of this. I feel that changing Warrington into a City is not something that is wanted by its residents and is an expensive and unnecessary plan.

Overall I would like my letter to express that I strongly oppose the proposals and in particular feel that Warrington Council have approached this in a way that does not consider the thoughts of the local people. The consultation process itself has been poor and I feel that people in the area have had very little awareness of the plans and little has been done to listen to the needs of Warrington residents.
