Dear Warrington Planning Policy Team,

We would like to raise a strong objection to the Warrington Development Plan.

The objection is based on the following areas of concern

- We do not believe that Warrington needs city status. It has always been a successful town, we have no desire to live in a city
- The reduction of green belt land. We believe that there are significant brown field sites without devastating the agricultural area in South Warrington. These sites would include the Fiddlers Ferry area.
- In South Warrington we have no travel infrastructure. No trains, buses stop running in our area in the early evening, the local roads will not cope with increased traffic. We do not believe the impact on the area and climate from increased traffic has been properly assessed.
- No environmental or ecological impact is included in the plan.
- The local healthcare infrastructure cannot cope with the current population. The dentist has closed its waiting list and we have to travel to central Warrington to get a doctor's appointment.
- The ability to work and live in an area surrounded by fields and walks will be completely obliterated to all Warrington residents if the area surrounding Walton, Grappenhall, Appleton and Stretton is subjected to the growth proposed.
