

Dear Sir / Madam

I am writing to express my strongest opposition to the above plan which is proposed for the development of Warrington.

You are proposing to destroy the beautiful green belt areas of the borough when significant amounts of brownfield sites already exist and this will turn areas of countryside into concrete jungles. The existing road infrastructure, schools, hospital and doctors' practices cannot even cope at present, so it beggars belief what will happen unless massive new investment is made into these requirements.

I cannot believe the plans have even reached this stage and having read your paper I noticed the following opening quote:-

"The Council undertook a 6 week period of consultation on the scope and contents of the Local Plan review and the Council's initial Local Plan evidence base between 24th October and 5th December 2016.

The Council received a total of 78 responses to the consultation. The majority were from developers and landowners although responses were also received from Parish Councils, local residents and other stakeholders."

I would respectfully suggest that this original consultation was either very low key or in fact selectively distributed as I cannot recall ever having seen the proposals. To receive only 78 responses to a proposal as wide ranging as planned is frankly laughable and I cannot believe it was a fair representation of people's views.

These plans must be reconsidered and proper thought given for the future of Warrington.
