Regarding the proposed development of properties on the land owned by [REDACTED] of Watercress Farm with access off Rushgreen Road through Grassmere, Mardale and Thirlmere Drive.

I strongly object to the building of any properties on this land. This is a densely populated housing estate with too many cars for houses (1960 build) which causes problems sometimes now with cars having to park on roads and it being difficult to get through, having building wagons, deliveries etc would be a nightmare.

I live in [REDACTED] and spent many months living through [REDACTED] refurbishment of his house Watercress Farm with dirty roads, not being able to get out of my drive sometimes for wagons, noise . I could go on and on. This is a very small road with limited turning access.

The whole estate is not adequate to take so much large heavy traffic and would cause mayhem for several years.

It seems ludicrous to me that planning for any extension to a house requires additional parking, easy access etc but allow a new development being built at the end if a small cul de sac with dreadful access roads.
