We wish to register our very strong objection to the various proposed developments in Croft.

Please will you confirm the dates and times of the public meetings to discuss these proposals so that we can attend. There should be a public meeting for such extensive proposals.

These proposals will have a huge negative impact on quality of life and village life in the future. They are not appropriate for a small village without the infrastructure to cope and which becomes too busy in any event before and after work.

The pre-school and primary schools are not sufficient to accommodate the increase in population.

Outside the primary school there is already dangerous congestion at school opening and closing times. The speed limit of 30 is not safe or appropriate. I have been just missed by the wing mirrors of a bus whilst walking on the pavement here and this will only get worse.

We do not have any shops in croft and there is no where that they can be built. People travel to the shops in the car.

The roads and infrastructure are not sufficient to cope.

Access to Culceth will become more difficult when HS2 is built. There will be congestion caused by the extra households on county roads even before HS2 forces traffic to take a different route in the future.

The site themselves are valuable land which is home to a variety of plant and animal life. We should be looking to redevelop disused sites, not cause urban sprawl.

Please confirm as soon as possible the public meetings to take place in connection with these proposals.
