>

> The consultation period has been rushed, especially as many local people will have been away during the summer.

> I am not at all sure we should aspire to be a 'city'.

> The plan is too developer biased.

> The local infrastructure in Lymm where I have lived since [REDACTED] is at breaking point already. Further large scale development can only lead to a deterioration of our village life.

> Schools and doctors surgeries are already oversubscribed.

> Any plan must enable the separate villages retain their distinct characteristics to prevent the whole area becoming one enormous uniform housing estate.

> It is essential to conserve the green belt land between the villages.

> Parking is a major problem in Lymm already.

> As a long term resident I am very aware how the last lot of major development has contributed to this issue.

> The fiddlers ferry power station is bound to close in the near future releasing substantial brownfield sites.
