Notice is hereby given in accordance with regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) regulations 2012 (as amended) that Warrington Borough Council submitted the Warrington Updated Proposed Submission Version Local Plan 2021-2038 to the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities on the 22nd April 2022 for independent examination.
