NOTIFICATION OF HIGHWAY WORKS

Please find overleaf a plan showing details of the heritage works to the sett paved section of Pepper Street between Rectory Lane and just east of Grove Rise.

Following the public consultation in October 2022, over 60% of respondents voted in favour of laying reclaimed stone setts in the road.

Due to the difficult nature of the works, it will be necessary to close the road, and its side roads, in order to reconstruct the road and lay the stone setts.

The information plan details the various stages of works, working times and when the road(s) will be closed and for how long.

The Principal Contractor for this scheme is Tarmac Trading Ltd.

Please ensure that all vehicles are removed from the road during the working hours, vehicles obstructing the works (road and/or footway) may be removed.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and vehicular access will be under the control of the Principal Contractor. Residents/businesses needing access to closed sections of road will need to speak to the contractors on site about this.
