THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (A49 NEWTON ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF U-TURN) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Council made an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 18th September 2024. The effect of the Order is to prohibit Motor Vehicles proceeding along the **A49 Newton Road** towards Delph Lane/Townfield Lane in a northerly direction from making a U-turn at the traffic signals, so as to proceed southerly in the opposite direction. The Order will be effective from 19th September 2024.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 18th September 2024, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
