Notice is hereby given that the Council made an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers on 27th November 2024. The effect of the Order is to introduce a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice to the extent as detailed in the said Schedule, resulting in the roads specified no longer retaining their historical de-restricted classification.

The Order will be effective from 28th November 2024.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 27th November 2024, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Glaziers Lane - For its entire length.

Cross Lane - From its junction with A574 Warrington Road to approximately 330 metres west of same.
