WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) CONSOLIDATION (AMENDMENT NO.67) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers. The effect of the Order will be as follows: -

- 1. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation (Amendment No. 4) (Part 1) Order 2019 is revoked in so far as it relates to Schedule 2, Article (g) and the addition to Schedule 3 - No waiting at any time - Statham Avenue (Both Sides) From its junction with Whitbarrow Road, for a distance of 10 metres, in a westerly direction.
- 2. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation (Amendment No. 64) Order 2024 is revoked in so far as it relates to the Schedule, Article (b) and the addition to Schedule 3 – No waiting at any time - Highfield Avenue (South East Side) From its junction with Liverpool Road for a distance of 51 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 3. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation Order 2018, is hereby further varied or amended as follows: -
 - (a) In the 3rd Schedule by the **deletion** of: -

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

From its junction with Warrington Road for a distance of 26 metres in a northerly **Tavistock Road** (Both Sides) direction.

(b) In the 3rd Schedule by the **addition** of: -

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Clay Lane (South Side)	From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Mercer Street to a point 10 metres east of its junction with Mercer Street.

Fairclough Street (East Side)	From its junction with Clay Lane for a distance of 12 metres in a southerly direction.
Fairclough Street (West Side)	From its junction with Clay Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
Highfield Avenue, Great Sankey (South East Side)	From its junction with Liverpool Road for a distance of 44 metres in a south westerly direction.

From its junction with Farrell Street for a distance of 60 metres in a Howley Lane (North East Side) south easterly direction.

Mercer Street From its junction with Clay Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a

southerly direction. (Both Sides)

Penny Lane from a point 94 metres southwest of its junction with Collins Green

Lane for a distance of 18 metres in a south westerly direction. (South East Side)

Statham Avenue, Lymm From its junction with Whitbarrow Road, for a distance of 84 metres, in

(North Side) a south westerly direction.

Statham Avenue, Lymm From its junction with Whitbarrow Road, for a distance of 86 metres, in

(South Side) a south westerly direction.

Tavistock Road From a point 96 metres south of its junction with Withycombe Road to

(East Side) its junction with Warrington Road.

Tavistock Road From a point 80 metres south of its junction with Withycombe Road to

its junction with Warrington Road. (West Side)

The Weint From its junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 44 metres in a

Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the south west side of Egerton Street which is bounded on the south west side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 74 metres south east of its junction with Ellesmere Road, in a south easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the south west side of Oldham Street which is bounded on the south west side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 6.6 metres south east of Shrewsbury Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
All that part of the north east side of Grange Avenue which is bounded on the north east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 56 metres north west of its junction with Reynolds Street in a north westerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.	Parallel to the kerb

All that part of the south east kerb line of Collin Street which is bounded on the south east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from a point 21.5 metres north east of its junction with Leicester Street in a north easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 1.8 metres.
